

'Crosse out Cancer!' Showcase Coming to Johnson Controls Hall of Fame Village Sports Complex

Lakewood, Ohio – August 20, 2019 – Burning River Lacrosse announced that in partnership with the Cleveland Clinic and Johnson Controls Hall of Fame Village Sports Complex, it will hold the 10th annual *'Crosse out Cancer! (COC)* college lacrosse showcase on Saturday October 5, 2019 in Canton, Ohio.

The event will benefit the *Comprehensive Breast Cancer Program at Cleveland Clinic*.
